

SUMMARY:

ELECTION OF IOMICA EXECUTIVE

Nominations are now called for the inaugural IOMICA Executive, elections are to be held at Vancouver.

The IOMICA nomination requirements have been revised and in light of these changes all posts will remain open for nominations until May 23rd 2003.

Competitors and World Council members (WCMs) at Vancouver vote for the inaugural IOMICA Executive.

- Proxies are permitted.
- Election takes place for each Executive position in sequence, one position at a time.
- There may be up to three rounds of voting if there are more than four candidates for a position.
- A candidate shall be an IOM Owner, and if an official of his/her DM or NCA or if an NCS shall undertake to resign such position within four months if successfully elected.
- A person can seek election for more than one position.
- Immediately a candidate is successful, his/her name is removed from the ballot for any later position.
- A candidate can withdraw at any time.
- Candidates do not have to be present at Vancouver, they can be elected in their absence.
- Candidates need four (4) nominators.
- Nominators must be either current or previous World championship competitors, or a WCM.
- At least two nominators must be from a country different from the candidate's.
- Nominators cannot give their name more than six (6) times (or four (4) times for nominators who are not WCMs) for any combination of candidates and positions.
- In the event that fewer than two nominations are received by this date for a particular position, nominations will remain open for that position until Friday 23 May 2003.
- WCMs are allocated the number of votes they can use depending upon the number of IOM Owners they have previously declared in their country, or upon their RSD category otherwise.
- Competitors agree with their WCM how to use their allocated votes, or, if they do not have a WCM, amongst themselves.
