Web site policy and procedures

Major Draft Version 1 dated September 18, 2001

The IOM class and IOM ICA Web site shall be maintained by its Webmaster in accordance with these principles and procedures.

1. The exclusive object of the site shall be the promotion of the IOM class. The site shall be known as the IOM class Web site and/or the IOM ICA Web site.
2. Material published on the site shall be in the name of the IOM ICA.
3. Additions, deletions, and changes to the content of the site shall be by resolution of the Executive Committee.
4. Site content shall be official material similar but not limited to the following:
 - IOM ICA structure and governance documents (such as Constitution, Regulations, discussion papers).
 - IOM ICA and IOM class publications (such as class rules, interpretations, measurement forms, exemplar NoR and SSI, guides and guidance notes, newsletters).
 - URLs, e-mail addresses, and contact information of Member NCAs and NCSs.
 - URLs of ISAF and ISAF-RSD.
 - Executive Committee and World Council business documents and official notifications (such as minutes, agendas, resolutions proposed, requests for interpretations, communications from ISAF, ISAF-RSD, and other relevant bodies).
5. The appearance, layout, navigation, and structure of the site shall be at the discretion of the site Webmaster.
6. There shall only be one official site. Only the official site shall claim, state, represent, imply, or hold itself out as the IOM class Web site and/or the IOM ICA Web site.
7. Except by resolution of the Executive Committee on a case by case basis, no other Web site shall:
 - Claim, state, represent, imply, or hold itself out as having recognition, approval, affiliation, authority, or authorisation by, with, to, for, or from the IOM class or the IOM ICA.
 - Display or use the IOM logo in any shape, size, form, colour, or treatment.

8. The Webmaster shall be competent to ask all other Web sites to comply with these requirements, and shall report any non-compliance to the Executive Committee.
9. The Webmaster shall ensure the site carries at all times:
 - The IOM logo.
 - An appropriate disclaimer page.
 - Up to date contact details for the Executive Committee and for the Webmaster.
